34		Mk 6:6	Went round about the villages	
35		Lk 9:1-6	The sending of the 12 (not to Samaria, not to Gentiles, to the lost sheep of Israel)	
36		Lk 9:10-17	Feeding the multitude with 5 loaves and 2 fishes at Bethsaida	
37		Jo 6:16-21	Walking on the water in the Sea of Galilee	
38		Mt 14:34-36	At Gennesaret, healing all of them that were diseased, touching the hem of his garment

42		Mt 15:29-38	Return to Galilee, a mountain near Decapolis (area southeast of sea of Galilee), healing many, feeding of 4000+ with 7 loaves and a few little fishes	
43		Mt 15:39, 16:1-4	To the coasts of Magdala, visit by Pharisees and Sadducees: "There shall be no sign but the sign of the prophet Jonah."	
44		Mt 16:5-12	Return to Bethsaida, "Beware of the doctrine of the Pharisees and the Sadducees."	
45		Mt 16:13-20	To the coasts of Caesarea Philippi (north of sea of Galilee), Peter answered, "Thou art the Christ the Son of the living God."	
46		Mt 17: 1-13	The transfiguration	
47		Mt 17:14-21	Healing of a boy with an unclean spirit	
48		Mt 17:22-23	Remaining in Galilee: "The son of man shall be betrayed into the hands of men."	
49		Mt 17:24-18:35	At Capernaum, teachings regarding: money from a fish, have the humility of a child, the lost sheep, if your brother sins against you, parable of the unforgiving servant	
50		Jo 7:1	Remaining in Galilee because the Judeans sought to kill him.	
51		Judea	Jo 7:2	Feast of Tabernacles is at hand, 4-12 October 27 AD
52			Jo 7:1-10	Travel to Jerusalem
